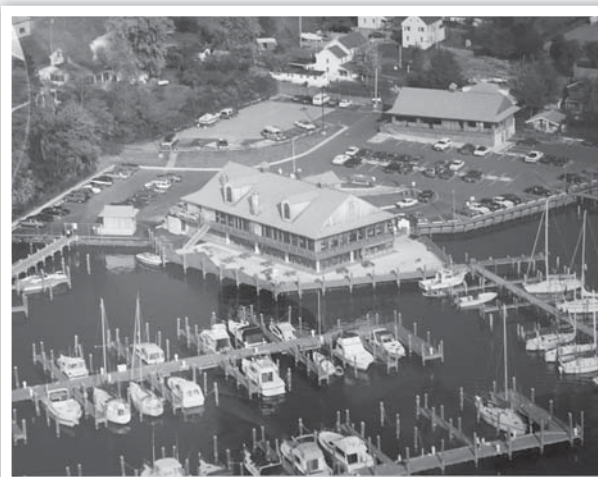


THE MARINA

The GRANARY MARINA is located in Georgetown Harbor, on the Sassafras River. The Sassafras River is a fresh water tributary of the Chesapeake Bay ... great for contact water sports; knee boarding, wake boarding, sail boarding and, of course, swimming.

The Granary Marina offers off street parking. Parking area is lighted for your safety. Restrooms and showers are air conditioned, humidity controlled for air purity and your comfort. A coin laundry ... keep your boat laundry separate from your home laundry !

Available electricity is 120 volts at 30 amps, 240 volts at 50 amps, single and three phase. Limited electricity on Docks N, O and P, share (1) 30 amp/120 volt receptacle among four slips.

ELECTRIC CHARGES

First 30 amp 120 volt shore power cord - Free
 Second 30 amp 120 volt shore power cord - \$250.00 one time charge
 Single 50 amp 220 volt shore power cord - \$450.00 one time charge
 *Limited electricity on Docks N, O and P, share (1) 30 amp/120 volt receptacle among four slips.

BOAT LIFTS;

Manual lift for small boats - \$425.00
 Electric lift for small boats - \$800.00
 10,000 lb electric lift - \$1,500.00 PLUS regular slip price
 15,000 lb electric lift - \$2,000.00 PLUS regular slip price

DOCKAGE PERIODS

Eight (8) months - April 1st to November 30th
 Monthly - any consecutive 30 day or longer stay — \$1.25 per foot LOD per day
 Weekly - any consecutive 7 day or longer stay — \$1.50 per foot LOD per day
 Daily - any one day stay or multiples thereof — \$2.00 per foot LOD per day

NOTE: NO DOCKAGE DURING THE MONTHS OF DECEMBER, JANUARY, FEBRUARY AND MARCH.
 Potable water system, restrooms are winterized during the winter months.

LOD means length of vessel on deck, not including anchor pulpits, bowsprits, swim platforms, davits and boomkins.

NOTE: Slip must be large enough to contain the entire vessel, including tie off space and, if required, room for a small boat (dinghy or skiff) within the slip.
